

NOTIFICATION – WEARING OF CAMO ON RANGES

At the SAPSA Executive Meeting held on Saturday 4th October, 2008, it was unanimously agreed to adopt a country-wide restriction on the wearing of camo at all IPSC shooting events.

Consequently, and with immediate effect, all competitors attending any level IPSC match within the South African region will not be allowed to wear any camouflage garments including caps.

Camo shooting bags, earmuffs and firearms are acceptable. I guess camo boots would be acceptable as in a few paces they will be adequately covered in dust anyway.

In terms of para 5.3 of the IPSC Handgun, Rifle and Shotgun Rules, (January 2006 Edition) Appropriate Dress is defined as “*Rule 5.3.1 - The use of camouflage or other similar types of military or police garments is **discouraged**. The exception is competitors who are law enforcement or military personnel. The Match Director will be the final authority in respect of what garments competitors are allowed to wear.*”

In future, if you turn up to a match wearing camo you will be requested to change or leave.
