

If anyone else has any better info please let's hear it.

This is not bashing the Dashprod rifle, it is good for what it is, and cheap.

We are aware that some shooters have bought, or are considering buying, the Dashprod SAR M14 semi auto rifle for IPSC 3 Gun shooting.

Please be aware that, due to its short barrel length, it is not likely that the minor power factor will be achieved with commonly available ammo.

A sample tested only chronoed at 2500 fps for a factor of 138 with local military ball ammo (required factor is 150)

To be fair it was an old rifle so the barrel could have been worn. Reloading could increase velocity but with what increased pressure?

Furthermore, and more definitive, the flash hider's diameter exceeds the 26mm limit for semi auto standard division thus placing it in open division.

Please remember that if a rifle does not make minor factor you can shoot but for fun only and not get points as your name will not be on the results.

It is understood that the Dashprod can be made available with a longer barrel and this should be actively pursued. If the longer barrel can be obtained and if the flash hider is still over diameter, it can be changed for an aftermarket compliant type.
