

### 3-Gun Match Format

This is a proposal to change the current format of how *NGPSA* is structuring their 3-Gun matches. We currently are following the IPSC rules to the letter in hosting the 3-Gun matches structured in the various components, Rifle, Shotgun, Handgun and awarding medals accordingly.

The proposal is to run *some matches* on the principle of “multi-gun” stages where two guns are used on the stage, in the following combinations:

Handgun combined with Shotgun,  
Handgun combined with Rifle,  
Rifle combined with shotgun.

A typical league will still be only 9 stages. This will have the effect that the component match competition is no longer possible and that there will be only an overall match winner. The only issue here is about the minor/major scoring of the weapon types, and the suggestion is that without making it a long and difficult discussion, that to register the competitors according to his handgun factor.

I am familiar with the rules about two guns being used per stages, but please read the rules as per Chap 5,8 and 10 and only then comment.

The plan is to run the match of 16 Aug 08 at Eeu Fees this way.
