

There is no provision in the IPSC Competition Rules for multi gun where two or more firearms are used in the same stage or match . Any such match will not fall under the IPSC Competition Rules except if prior approval has been granted by the IPSC Executive Committee.

With this in mind be aware that our insurance might not cover any accident or public liability as it is linked to participation in IPSC competitions. It should therefore not be published as an IPSC match as it isn't. Such a match should fall under 'SAPSA rules'.

Multi gun matches in the USA fall under USPSA rules and not IPSC Competition Rules.
